Our latest action in Burkina Faso: Paper for All distributed 350 notebooks, 100 pens, 100 pencils and 12 school books

- **Action:** In July 2007, Paper for All continued diversifying the scope of academic materials distributed to answer the needs of the pupils and provided notebooks, pencils and school books.
- **Approach:** As outlined by the school teachers, the 701 children still need support in getting the most basic goods such as pens and notebooks. In addition, they absolutely need school books to be able to learn more effectively, which is why this action was focused on this aspect too.
- **Results:** The feedback obtained from the pupils was excellent. It once again indicated that they were very happy to receive help for their academic efforts. Our sustained efforts will allow the seeds to slowly grow to become trees sheltering the next generation.



Our next action: October 2007

- Our next action is scheduled for October 2007. We will continue distributing notebooks and books as well as chalks for the teachers to start the new academic year in good conditions.

Our previous actions

- In April 2007, Paper for All distributed 350 notebooks as well as pens books, chalk and starter kits to the neediest children.
- In January 2007 Paper for All distributed 750 notebooks and 20 school books to the 701 children of the elementary school.
- In October 2006, Paper for All helped the 701 children start the new academic year in better conditions
- In June 2006, Paper for All distributed 300 notebooks to the elementary school.
