Latest actions in Burkina Faso

In April 2008, thanks to your support, Paper4All distributed 800 notebooks, 400 pens, 200 pencils, 25 boxes of chalk, and rulers for teachers across two schools in Ouagadougou: Ecole de la Cité de l'Avenir and Ecole Yaaka, for a total of 1,000 children for the two schools.

This action will allow pupils to finish the 2007-2008 school year with enough supplies, and professors to teach in better conditions. Children's parents were also delighted and wish the charity the best of luck in order to raise additional funds.

We count on our donators' support for our July distribution, which will aim to support summer courses and reward the pupils who worked the hardest over the school year.

Creation of the French Entity

The French entity of Paper4All is now officially operating! Set up by David Azoulay (President), Adelaide Chassort (Secretary) and Cyrus Farhangi (Treasurer), its purpose is to grow P4A's network in France and extend sources for funding. After only a few weeks of existence, 9 members are already on board. The first meeting took place on 8 April 2008, where each member has been allocated some responsibilities for the months to follow:

- Members will be contacting their university alumni for further extending the network
- Each member will be approaching their firm for potential funding
- Sending applications to Local Councils for obtaining subsidies
- Contacting other NGOs with similar objectives
- Refining communication strategy and content (facebook groups, French section of the website etc...)

The goal is soon to create a new funding channel, from France to Ouagadougou, extending Paper4All operations and distributing school supplies to new schools.
