



## Volunteering to teach in Burkina Faso

### Opportunity

- Teach during a month in Burkina Faso to 700 children aged 8-16 years old while discovering an amazing country.

### Requirements

- Experience in teaching preferred but not required
- Experience with living conditions in Africa preferred but not required
- Energy to do the right thing and help developing countries in a sustainable way
- Autonomy to organise courses but also teamwork to work with existing teachers and school directors
- Some level of French. Even though the African team speaks some English, it is strongly advised to have the ability to speak French to communicate with local people.
- Be autonomous to organise the trip. A separate 2-pages document on the country, required vaccines and equipment, visas, travel tickets, etc. can/must be read on the website.

### Cost

- The overall cost for one month is 200 pounds, or 300 euros, comprising accommodation, food and transport from/to the airport.

### Accommodation

- Villa with rooms equipped with fans, and a living room in Ouagadougou, the capital city
- Showers

### Food

- Breakfast: Coffee, butter, tea, bread (and possibly rice)
- Lunch: Rice, couscous, pasta, African dishes, foreign dishes, mangoes, bananas,
- Dinner: Depends on lunch (likely to be similar to lunch)

Note: Food requirements need to be confirmed with Alfred before leaving the origin country

### Activities

- 2-3 weeks to teach (English and/or French, Mathematics, Physics, etc.)
- 1 week to visit the country
  - Animal park of the country president in his birth city (Ziniare)
  - The granit site of Laongo
  - The Bangreweogo park
- Visits to Ouagadougou (capital city) as requested

Note: A dancing event will be organised in the end.
